The Bank clarifies that as per item No. 8 on the summary page of the Bill of Quantities, bidders are required to price for the use of their own technical consultants to design the Wall & Gate House (to the client's approval) and obtain necessary approvals from relevant statutory authorities (Nakuru County Government, NCA, NEMA, etc.)
2.	Whether the existing Perimeter wall will be demolished to pave way for the new boundary wall.	The Structural integrity of the existing perimeter wall will be decided once the contractor engages their consultant (this is part of the BOQ) and suitable structural tests conducted.
3.	Whether Survey Map (or drawings) with beacons will be provided to bidders	Survey Map (or drawings) with beacons will be provided to the successful bidder before construction commences.
4.	On the design of the Gate and Gate house to KSMS Standard	The successful bidder will be taken to CBK-IMS (formerly Kenya School of Monetary Studied - KSMS) to appreciate the design and construction. However, bidders are allowed to visit KSMS in Ruaraka, Nairobi to appreciate the anticipated design
5.	The ideal location of the gate	This will be decided once construction commences.
