
The MerQube US Small-Cap Vol Advantage Index attempts to provide a dynamic rules-based exposure to an unfunded rolling position in E-Mini® Russell 2000® futures (the "Futures Contracts"), which reference the Russell 2000® Index, while targeting a level volatility of 35%, with a maximum exposure to the Futures Contracts of 500% and a minimum exposure to the Futures Contracts of 0%.

The Index is subject to a 6.0% per annum daily deduction.

The Index was established on June 21, 2022.
