WHEREAS, hydropower can be adjusted in real time to complement Montana's diverse energy portfolio by providing the flexibility needed to maintain reliability, enhance grid security, and meet the growing demand for energy; and

WHEREAS, hydropower also enhances Montana's economic resilience by providing critical flood control and reliable irrigation for agriculture throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the hydropower industry depends upon a trained workforce to deliver reliable energy services to Montana communities, and employs many Montanans across the state; and
