## by Governor Jim Justice

- Whereas,** propane has been helping Americans meet their energy needs for more than 100 years; and
- Whereas,** West Virginia is the third leading propane producer in the United States; and
- Whereas,** propane is a clean burning and low-carbon fuel that provides critical energy to residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural customers across West Virginia and ensures a variety of market sectors can flourish; and
- Whereas,** propane is nontoxic and a federally-designated clean, alternative fuel that reduces emissions and improves air quality; and
- Whereas,** America is the world's leading propane producer; and propane supports energy security, reliability, and resilience, and helps consumers meet their unique heating and energy needs; and
- Whereas,** West Virginia's propane industry supports good-paying jobs, employs hundreds of workers, and contributes over \$2 billion in state economic activity annually.

**Now, Therefore,** Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *October 7, 2024* as:

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in observance.


**In Witness Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
