WHEREAS, Vermont Donation Day effectively serves to remind us we need to constantly

replenish our blood supply through donation and community awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Philip B. Scott, Governor, hereby proclaim the 4th day of September, 2024, as

BLOOD DONATION DAY

in Vermont.
