WHEREAS, addressing the complex medical needs early in life is imperative to helping families

successfully care for their children at home and the need for education, awareness

and support for families is desperately needed; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we recognize and spread awareness of Lissencephaly; and

WHEREAS, nonprofit organizations, like Lissencephaly Foundation Inc., continue to support

these effected individuals through their continued efforts of empowering families

and educating communities.
