Re: Estimate of H.R. 8467 Relative to CBO's June 2024 Baseline Projections

Dear Chairman Thompson and Chairwoman Stabenow:

In response to several requests, the Congressional Budget Office has prepared an updated cost estimate for H.R. 8467, the Farm, Food, and National Security Act of 2024, as ordered reported by the House Committee on Agriculture on May 23, 2024, and with subsequent amendments provided by the House Committee on Agriculture on July 30, 2024. In consultation with the House Committee on the Budget, CBO originally estimated the budgetary effects of that legislation relative to the May 2023 baseline. In this letter, CBO provides estimates of the changes in direct spending under that legislation relative to CBO's most recent baseline projections, from June 2024, for agriculture, conservation, and nutrition spending.

Relative to the June 2024 baseline projections for commodity prices, land conservation, and nutrition spending, CBO estimates that enacting the bill would increase direct spending by \$28.1 billion over the 2025-2034 period (see Table 1). Relative to the May 2023 baseline projections, CBO estimated that enacting H.R. 8467 would increase direct spending by \$33.0 billion over the 2025-2033 period. The difference between the two estimates is \$4.9 billion.

That difference is not exactly comparable, though, because of the additional year in the June 2024 baseline's estimating period. To make the differences between the estimates more parallel, in this letter CBO provides additional information for the bill as a whole and by title to reflect the differences between the two estimates over the same 2025-2033 period. The additional costs estimated for 2034 are presented as well.

Estimated Differences

Relative to the June 2024 baseline, enacting the bill would increase direct spending by \$25.2 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$7.8 billion less than CBO estimated relative to the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$2.9 billion.

The differences by title, relative to the June 2024 baseline, are shown below (see Table 2):

- Title I, Commodities, would increase direct spending by \$32.1 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$11.3 billion less than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$4.9 billion.
- Title II, Conservation, would increase direct spending by \$2.0 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$3.8 billion more than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$2.5 billion. (Under the May 2023 baseline, CBO estimated that title II would decrease direct spending by \$1.8 billion over the 2025-2033 period.)
- Title III, Trade, would increase direct spending by \$2.2 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is the same amount CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$0.2 billion.
- Title IV, Nutrition, would increase direct spending by \$8.9 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$1.2 billion less than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$1.2 billion.
- Title VI, Rural Development, would have no net effect on direct spending over the 2025-2033 period, which is the same effect CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, title VI would have no budgetary effect in 2034.

- Title VII, Research, Extension, and Related Matters, would increase direct spending by \$3.1 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$0.3 billion less than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$0.3 billion.
- Title VIII, Forestry, would have no significant effect on direct spending over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$10 million less than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, title VIII would have no significant budgetary effect in 2034.
- Title IX, Energy, would increase direct spending by \$50 million over the 2025-2033 period, which is the same amount CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, title IX would have no budgetary effect in 2034.
- Title X, Horticulture, Marketing, and Regulatory Reform, would increase direct spending by \$0.3 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$40 million less than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$30 million.
- Title XI, Crop Insurance, would increase direct spending by \$4.2 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$0.7 billion more than CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, costs in 2034 would total \$0.6 billion.
- Title XII, Miscellaneous Provisions, would decrease direct spending by \$26.5 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$0.5 billion less than the reduction (\$27.0 billion) CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, direct spending reductions in 2034 would total \$6.6 billion.
- Interactive effects between title IV and section 12401 would decrease direct spending by \$1.3 billion over the 2025-2033 period, which is \$47 million more than the reduction (\$1.2 billion) CBO estimated under the May 2023 baseline over that same period. Additionally, direct spending reductions in 2034 would total \$0.3 billion.

The budgetary effect of ending the sugar program would be a net decrease of \$90 million over the 2025-2034 period. If the bill's language was amended to reauthorize the sugar program, the combined effect of the reauthorization and the changes to the program would result in a net increase of \$65 million over the 2025-2034 period.

a. Subtitle C would change the sugar program. Because the bill would not update the statutory language to reauthorize the sugar program, CBO expects that the sugar program could not be implemented once the current authorization has expired, after the 2024 crop year.
