2024/2025 Deer Hunt Season Dates

The James River National Wildlife Refuge offers the following opportunities associated with the upcoming hunt season. Participation is authorized on the dates outlined below only by persons that have received a valid James River National Wildlife Refuge reservation or permit. Scout Dates: Saturday, Sept. 21, & Sunday, Sept. 22, as well as Sun, Oct. 20, & Monday, Oct. 21, 2024

No pre-registration or reservation required. During daylight hours, select gates will be unlocked to allow vehicle access into portions of the wildlife refuge's designated hunt zones solely for the purpose of scouting.

• Youth/Apprentice Deer Hunt: Saturday, Sept. 28, 2024

Pre-reservation is required through RecAccess (https://jamesrivernwr.recaccess.com). The website will accept pre-reservations within 48 hrs of the designated hunt date. Capacity thresholds are in place and accommodated on a first come/first serve basis. The participants will be assigned a particular zone (see Youth Hunt Map). The person accompanying the youth/apprentice hunter is required to establish the reservation through RecAccess, identify the name of the youth/apprentice hunter, be a valid hunting license holder, and not actively hunt during the event. The day of the hunt, persons that obtained pre-registration are to virtually sign-in and sign-out using RecAccess. Participants must place a copy of their RecAccess ID number on the dashboard of their vehicle while on the refuge.

<u>General Public Deer Hunts</u>: SATURDAYS ONLY- Saturday, Oct. 5, 12, 19, 26, Nov. 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, Dec. 7, 14, 21, 28, 2024, and Jan. 4, 2025. (note that the northern-most hunt areas will be closed to hunting after Dec. 7th).

Pre-reservation is required through RecAccess (https://jamesrivernwr.recaccess.com). The website will accept pre-reservation requests within 48 hrs of the designated hunt date. Capacity thresholds are in place and accommodated on a first come/first serve basis. The hunter is required to establish the reservation through RecAccess, be a valid hunting license holder, and have read/understood the regulations of the specific day's hunt. Participants must virtually sign-in and sign-out using RecAccess. Participants are to place a copy of their RecAccess ID number on the dashboard of their vehicle while on the refuge. Parking along public roads is prohibited.
