Red Wolf Program: Join refuge staff in learning about the history and biology of red wolves. Programs include a talk about the red wolves and the ability to visit the live red wolves at the red wolf center. Programs are only offered at the times listed.

There is no guarantee that you will be able to see the exhibit red wolves as they are a shy and elusive species

Wintering Waterfowl Tour: Join refuge staff for a guided tour of the Pungo Unit to observe the magnificent migratory waterfowl. The tour will provide details about the role Pungo plays in providing a waterfowl sanctuary and include information on Tundra Swan and other waterfowl migration! This is a follow-the-leader tour with participants driving their own vehicle following the tour leader. Vehicles are subject to road conditions on the Pungo Unit. It is recommended to arrive with a full tank of gas and to be driving in a 4WD capable vehicle to avoid getting stuck on the refuge. Roads on the refuge have a weight limit of 8,000lbs. The tour will begin at the Pungo Unit Kiosk located near 600 Refuge Rd Pantego, NC.

Tours will not be offered in inclement weather. Pocosin Lakes National Wildlife Refuge is not responsible for vehicles getting stuck on the refuge at your own risk
