Report Highlights:

Ukraine introduced procedures for the approval of minimum export prices for selected bulk commodities, including grains, oilseeds, vegetable oils and meals, walnuts, and honey.

On August 21, 2024, The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine adopted the Resolution #944 “On Approval of the Procedure for Setting of Minimum Export Prices for Certain Types of Goods.” The Ukrainian version is available via [this link](#) and attached to this report.

According to the resolution, the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine (MAPFU) determines the minimum export prices, taking into account the terms related to the delivery of commodities based on [Incoterms](#) for a limited list of commodities:

- Honey (HS Code 0409 00 00 00)
- Walnuts (HS Codes 0802 31 00 00 and 0802 32 00 00)
- Wheat (HS Code 1001)
- Rye (HS Code 1002)
- Barley (HS Code 1003)
- Oats (HS Code 1004)
- Corn (HS Code 1005)
- Soybeans (HS Code 1201)
- Rapeseed (HS Code 1205)
- Sunflower Seeds (HS Code 1206 00)
- Soybean and Sunflower and Rapeseed Oils (HS Codes 1507, 1512, and 1514)
- Vegetable Meals (HS Code 2306).

Exports of listed commodities are prohibited when the contract price is below the minimum export price (referenced in U.S. dollars per kilogram) published by MAPFU on its official website.

This measure is expected to come into force by early November 2024, according to information available to FAS/Kyiv.
