## **NRC Renews Comanche Peak Operating Licenses**

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has <u>renewed</u> the operating licenses of Comanche Peak Units 1 and 2 for an additional 20 years.

Comanche Peak Units 1 and 2 are pressurized-water reactors about 40 miles southwest of Fort Worth, Texas. Unit 1's operating license will now expire Feb. 8, 2050, and Unit 2's on Feb. 2, 2053.

The NRC's review of the application proceeded on two tracks. A <u>safety evaluation report</u> was issued in March, and a final supplemental <u>environmental impact statement</u> was issued in April. These documents, as well as other information regarding the Comanche Peak license renewal application, are available on the NRC <u>website</u>, which also contains information about the license renewal process.
