**REQUEST TO EXTEND TIME TO NEGOTIATE INTERIM TRAIL USE
AND FEE WAIVER REQUEST**

Pursuant to 49 CFR § 1152.29(d)(1)(ii), the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) hereby requests the Surface Transportation Board (Board) order a one-year extension of the Notice of Interim Trail Use (NITU), or **until November 18, 2025**, applicable to the rail line in the above-referenced abandonment proceeding. Pursuant to the decision served by the Board on November 1, 2023, the current period for negotiation of interim trail use/rail banking is set to expire on November 18, 2024. V and S Railway, LLC (V&S) has authorized MDNR to state that V&S agrees to an extension of the deadline. This request is the second extension request made by MDNR in this proceeding.

Since the Board's decision, MDNR and V&S have been in continuing discussions, but have not finalized their negotiations for interim trail use. The parties are optimistic that these negotiations will be resolved prior to the extension date requested.
