CSX TRANSPORTATION, INC.—ABANDONMENT EXEMPTION—IN CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO

Decided: September 28, 2023

CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSXT), filed a verified notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. part 1152 subpart F—<u>Exempt Abandonments</u> to abandon an approximately 1.3-mile rail line between milepost BJB 73.21 and milepost BJB 74.51 on its Cleveland Subdivision in Cuyahoga County, Ohio (the Line). Notice of the exemption was served and published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on September 1, 2023 (88 Fed. Reg. 60,526). The exemption is scheduled to become effective on October 1, 2023.

The Board's Office of Environmental Analysis (OEA) served a Draft Environmental Assessment on September 8, 2023, solicited comments, and issued a Final Environmental Assessment on September 28, 2023. No environmental or historic preservation issues were raised by any party or identified by OEA. Accordingly, a finding of no significant impact under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.10(g) will be made pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1011.7(a)(2)(ix).

It is ordered:

- 1. Abandonment of the Line will have no significant effect on the quality of the human environment and conservation of energy resources or on historic resources.
- 2. If consummation has not been effected by CSXT's filing of a notice of consummation by September 1, 2024, and there are no legal or regulatory barriers to consummation, the authority to abandon will automatically expire.
 - 3. This decision is effective on its service date.
