GROWTH RESOURCES OF WELLSBORO FOUNDATION—ABANDONMENT EXEMPTION—IN TIOGA COUNTY, PA.

Decided: December 12, 2022

Growth Resources of Wellsboro Foundation (GROW) filed a verified notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. part 1152 subpart F—<u>Exempt Abandonments</u> to abandon approximately 3.27 miles of rail line between milepost 0.624 and milepost 3.9 in Wellsboro, Tioga County, Pa. (the Line). Notice of the exemption was served and published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on November 15, 2022 (87 Fed. Reg. 68,568). The exemption is scheduled to become effective on December 15, 2022.

The Board's Office of Environmental Analysis (OEA) served a Draft Environmental Assessment on November 17, 2022, solicited comments, and issued a Final Environmental Assessment on December 8, 2022. No environmental or historic preservation issues were raised by any party or identified by OEA. Accordingly, a finding of no significant impact under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.10(g) will be made pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1011.7(a)(2)(ix).

It is ordered:

- 1. Abandonment of the Line will have no significant effect on the quality of the human environment and conservation of energy resources or on historic resources.
- 2. If consummation has not been effected by GROW's filing of a notice of consummation by November 15, 2023, and there are no legal or regulatory barriers to consummation, the authority to abandon will automatically expire.
 - 3. This decision is effective on its service date.
