### VERIFIED NOTICE OF EXEMPTION OF GEORGES CREEK DIVISION RAILROAD, LLC PURSUANT TO 49 C.F.R. PART 1150, SUBPART D

Georges Creek Division Railroad LLC ("GCDR"), a non-carrier, hereby files this notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. part 1150, subpart D, for authorization to acquire by lease, and to conduct common carrier operations over, certain railroad lines (the "Lines") located in Maryland as described below. In so doing, GCDR will, upon transaction consummation, assume a common carrier status on the Lines.

In accordance with the requirements of 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33, GCDR submits the following information:

### Statement Concerning Agreement: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(c)

GCDR and the Lines' owner, Eighteen Thirty Group, LLC ("Eighteen Thirty"), are finalizing terms of a "Land and Rail Assets Lease Agreement" (the "Agreement") pursuant to which GCDR will assume a leasehold interest in the long-inactive Lines. Western Maryland Scenic Railroad Development Corporation ("WMSR"), a non-carrier, controls GCDR. Further, GCDR was created for the specific purpose of assuming a common carrier status on the Lines as is required of GCDR under the terms of the Agreement. In the interest of full disclosure, the principal objective of the present transaction is to enable WMSR to expand its intrastate excursion and railroad tourism offerings in the region by adding the Lines to its portfolio. For that reason, the Agreement permits GCDR to enter into a sublease agreement with WMSR beyond the scope of the Board's jurisdiction pursuant to which WMSR would assume all rights and obligations in the Lines under the lease *except* for (as applicable) the right and obligation to offer and to provide railroad common carrier service, which GCDR would retain.

### Operation of the Property: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(d)

As applicable, GCDR will offer common carrier service over the Lines upon consummation of the proposed transaction, on or after the effective date of this exemption.

### Summary of the Transaction: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(e)

As applicable here, GCDR¹ is invoking the subject class exemption procedures to lease from Eighteen Thirty,² and to conduct common carrier operations (as applicable) over, the Lines, which are as follows (comprising a total of 14.49 route miles): (a) roughly 13.94 miles of railroad line consisting of a portion of the former CSXT Transportation, Inc. ("CSXT") Georges Creek Subdivision between approximately Milepost BAI 31.6 at Westernport, Maryland, and approximately Milepost BAI 18.46 at the end of the line at Carlos/Shaft, Maryland; and (b) roughly 0.55 miles of railroad consisting of a portion of the former CSXT Thomas Subdivision from approximately Milepost BAH 26.25 at Barton, Maryland, to the end of track at approximately Milepost BAH 26.80 at Westernport, Maryland.³

Eighteen Thirty Acquired the Lines (all long inactive) via two separate Board-authorized transactions. See Eighteen Thirty Group, LLC – Acquisition Exemption – Lines of CSX Transportation, Inc., FD 35927 (STB served May 15, 2015); CSX Transportation, Inc. – Abandonment Exemption – In Allegany County, Md., AB-55 (Sub-No. 659X) (STB served Dec. 30, 2010); and Eighteen Thirty Group, LLC – Acquisition Exemption – In Allegany County, Md., FD

### Map: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(f)

### Certification: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(g)

GCDR's projected annual revenue will not result in the creation of a Class II or Class I rail carrier under the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 1201 (1-1). A Certificate complying with the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(g) is attached.

### Interchange Commitments: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33(h)

The Agreement governing this transaction does not contractually limit GCDR from interchanging of traffic with any connecting carrier. See Certification and Verification (attached). As matters now stand, GCDR's only interline

### <u>Advance Notice</u>: 49 C.F.R. § 1150.32(e)

GCDR's projected annual revenue is not expected to exceed \$5 million, and, accordingly, the advance notice requirements of 49 C.F.R. § 1150.32(e) are not applicable to this transaction. See Certification and Verification (attached).

### Environmental and Historic Preservation Data: 49 C.F.R. § 1105

Under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.6(c)(2), the proposed lease and operation of the Line is exempt from environmental reporting requirements. GCDR's common carrier operations would not result in significant changes in carrier operations, *i.e.*, changes that exceed the thresholds established in 49 C.F.R. § 1105.7(e)(4) or (5).

Under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.8(b)(1), GCDR's proposed operation of the Line also is exempt from historic preservation reporting requirements, as the proposed change of operators is not expected to impact historic structures along the Line that are 50 years old or older.


