INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Government of Grenada (GOGR) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) in an amount equivalent to **US\$5 Million**, towards the cost of the Climate Smart Agriculture and Rural Enterprise Programme (the Project) and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract. Payment by CDB will be made only at the request of GOGR and upon approval by CDB and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOGR shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

The Project is being implemented by the Ministry of Economic Development, Planning, Agriculture & Lands, Forestry, Marine Resources & Co-operatives (Ministry of Economic Development) through its Rural Development Unit (RDU). The Ministry of Economic Development has contracted a Consultant who will assist the RDU with delivering the Project. The Consultant has prepared designs and contract documentation and will assist in tender administration and evaluation and supervise Project activities.

The Rural Development Unit (RDU) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **Construction service for the Implementation of Irrigation Infrastructure in:**

- **Limlair Pond, Carriacou, Lot 1A**
- **Belair Pond, Carriacou, Lot 1B**
- **Dumfries Well, Carriacou, Lot 1C;**

The works include, but are not limited to the following:

Limlair Pond, Carriacou:

1. Supply and construction of an Animal Drinking Trough, RC Silt Traps and RC Staircase.

2. Supply and installation of metal access gates and handrails to the RC staircase.
3. Supply and construction of a Concrete Capping and RC Foundation to the existing well.
4. Construction of a steel structure above the existing well inclusive of an aluminum frame for solar panels mount.
5. Supply and installation of electrical components (Solar PV Panels, Solar Inverter, Submersible Pump, Control Box, Float Switch and associated cables).
6. Supply and installation of a Fibergrate Cover to the well inclusive of all shingles and handles.
7. Construction of a boardwalk to the existing well.
8. Supply and installation of a Drip Irrigation System.
9. Desilting the base of the pond to the satisfaction of the Engineer.
10. Supply and installation of a chain link fence inclusive of a concrete kerb at the bottom along the S and W perimeter of the pond.

Landscaping by planting Vetiver Grass, Almond and African Tulip Trees to the N and E perimeter of the pond which are to be installed and grown in by the Contractor.

Belair Pond, Carriacou

1. Supply and construction of a Concrete Swale, RC Catchpit, RC Silt Traps, RC Box Culvert with Headwalls and Wingwalls, Speed Bump, RC Stepped Box Drains and RC Staircase.
2. Supply and installation of a metal access gate and handrails to the RC staircase.
3. Supply and installation of a chain link fence along the roadside inclusive of a concrete kerb at the bottom.
4. Landscaping by planting Vetiver Grass around the pond bank and African Tulips to the NE side of the pond which are to be installed and grown in by the Contractor.

Cleaning of the base of the pond inclusive of extracting, carting away and burning the existing water hyacinth at an approved site.

Dumfries Well, Carriacou

1. Cleaning/Wire-brushing of the existing external and internal well walls
2. Removal of the accumulated silt at the base of the well to the satisfaction of the Engineer.
3. Construction of a Reinforced Concrete 3-stage Animal Drinking Trough against 180 degrees of the perimeter of the existing well wall.
4. Construction of a Reinforced Concrete Capping and Footing to the perimeter of the existing well.
5. Construction of a steel roof structure inclusive of guttering and downpipes.
6. Supply and installation of electrical components (Solar PV Panels, Solar Inverter, Submersible Pump, Control Box, Float Switches and associated cables).
7. Supply and installation of associated PVC pipeworks.

Supply and installation of Fibergrate Cover to the well inclusive of all shingles and handles.

Consideration will be limited to firms or joint ventures of firms, which are legally incorporated or otherwise organised in, and have their principal place of business in an eligible country and are either:

- (a) more than 50% beneficially owned by a citizen or citizens and/or a bona fide resident or residents of an eligible country, or by a body corporate or bodies corporate meeting these requirements; or
- (b) owned or controlled by the Government of an eligible country provided that it is legally and financially autonomous and operated under the commercial law of an eligible country and otherwise meets the eligibility requirements of the CDB Guidelines for Procurement (2006).

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.

Eligible bidders will be required to submit full qualification information with their bids establishing their eligibility to bid and qualification to perform the contract if the bid is accepted. Tender and qualification information are to be submitted in the English Language on the prescribed forms inserted in the Bid Documents. Submissions that do not provide the information required, or do not demonstrate the prospective contractor's ability to perform satisfactorily, will not qualify and will not be considered for further evaluation.

Qualification requirements include, inter alia:

- (a) an average annual turnover (defined as certified payments received for works in progress or completed) within the last five (5) years, as follows:
 - **Limlair Pond, Carriacou** - Two Million Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$2,250,000.00);
 - **Belair Pond, Carriacou** - Six Hundred and Fifty Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$650,000.00);
 - **Dumfries Well, Carriacou** – Two Hundred Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$200,000.00);
- (b) a demonstrable cash flow (including access to credit) as follows:
 - **Limlair Pond, Carriacou** - Three Hundred and Seventy-five Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$375,000.00);
 - **Belair Pond, Carriacou** - One Hundred and Ten Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$110,000.00);
 - **Dumfries Well, Carriacou** – Seventy Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$70,000.00);
- (c) experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least two (2) assignments of a nature, scope and complexity comparable to the proposed project activity within the last five (5) years (to comply with this requirement, works quoted should be at least 80 percent complete).

Bidding Documents may be obtained by eligible bidders from the first address below for a non-refundable fee of **\$500.00**. Requests may be made by written application including email. Written applications must be clearly marked: **“Request for Bidding Documents for Construction service for the Implementation of Irrigation Infrastructure in Limlair Pond, Lot 1A, Belair Pond Lot 1B and Dumfries Well Lot 1C** along with the name, address and contact information of the bidder for which Bidding Documents are being requested. Payment should be by bank draft or bank guaranteed cheque made payable to: **The Government of Grenada**.

Applicants who request that documents be forwarded to them must submit an account number from a local courier agent that accepts freight collect charges. Documents will be promptly dispatched, but

under no circumstance will the Ministry of Economic Development/RDU or their authorised agent be held responsible for late delivery or loss of the documents so transmitted.

Submissions in sealed envelopes clearly marked **“Bid for Construction service for the Implementation of Irrigation Infrastructure in Limlair Pond, Lot 1A, Belair Pond Lot 1B, and Dumfries Well, Lot 1C** must be received at the second address below not later than **3:00 p.m.** (local time) on **October 18, 2024**. Bid opening will take place immediately after the deadline for submission at the second address below in the presence of bidders representatives who choose to attend. Qualification information **only** must be simultaneously submitted to the third address below.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of Nine Thousand Eastern Caribbean Dollars (XCD\$9,000.00).

The GOCR reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected prospective bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected prospective bidder(s) of the grounds for Ministry of Economic Development/RDU action. Ministry of Economic Development/RDU will not defray any costs incurred by any bidder in the preparation of bids.
