On November 21, the members of KEIDANREN (Japan Business Federation) visited the Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Nuclear Power Station.

During the visit, they were shown a reservoir water spray drill, the operating floor of Unit 7 reactor building, and the central control room, etc.

Following the visit, Mr. Tokura, the chairman of KEIDANREN, commented that, “I would like to express my gratitude once again for the contributions that the people in the area of the plant have made over the years to supply energy for the basis of people’s life and economy. During this visit, I was impressed by the substantial preparations for earthquake or tsunami, and the effort to foster an autonomous safety culture by all employees at the plant. Nowadays, securing clean power sources such as nuclear power has become increasingly important as a condition for industrial location. I hope to gain the understanding of the local people and to be able to resume operations sooner.”

TEPCO will continue to maintain/improve the safety and reliability of its power stations and encourage as much of the general public as possible to come and see conditions at the site as Kashiwazaki-Kariwa aims to become a power station that is trusted by society.
