

# Internal Migration in October 2021

- The number of internal migrants was 540 thousand persons in October 2021, which fell by 10.7% from October 2020.
- In October 2021, the internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 12.4%, which went down by 1.5%p from October 2020.

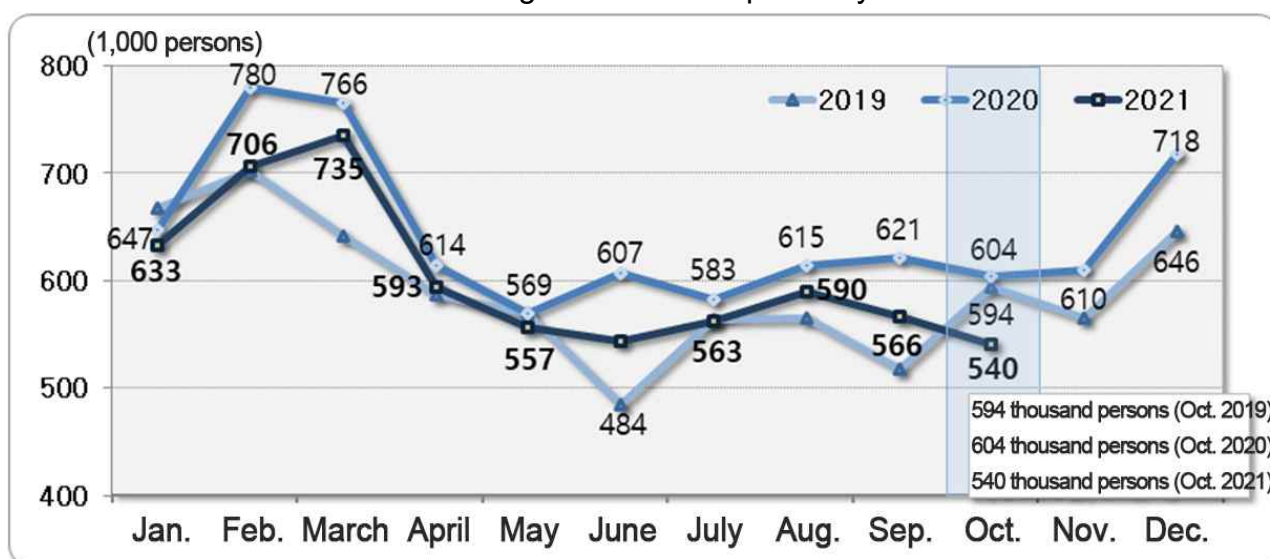

## 1. Internal migration

- The number of internal migrants was 540 thousand persons in October 2021, dropping by 10.7% (64 thousand persons) from October 2020.
- The intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants took up 67.6% and 32.4% of the total internal migrants in October 2021, respectively.
- Compared to October 2020, the intra-province migrants and the inter-province migrants fell by 13.2% and 4.8%, respectively.

- The internal migration rate (the number of migrants per 100 population) stood at 12.4%, which went down by 1.5%p from October 2020.

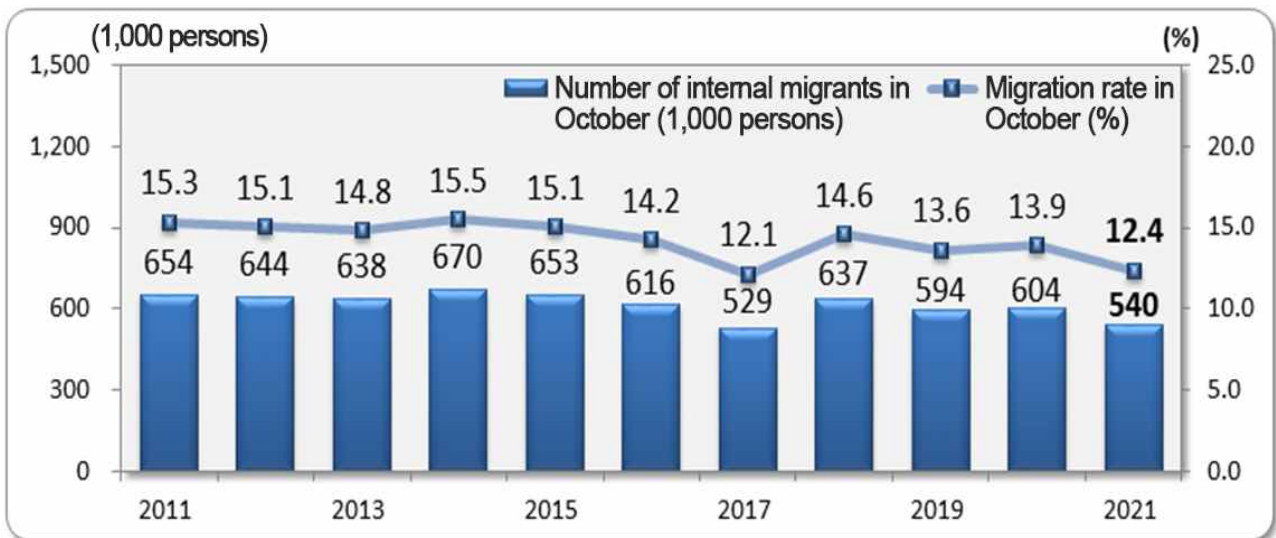

## 2. Internal migration for metropolitan cities and provinces

- Regarding the net migration of metropolitan cities and provinces, 8 regions recorded a plus net migration.: Gyeonggi (6,525 persons), Incheon (3,294 persons), Sejong (1,509 persons) and so on. On the other hand, 9 regions recorded a minus net migration.: Seoul (-9,389 persons), Daegu (-1,695 persons), Busan (-1,615 persons) and so on.
- Sejong, Incheon and Gangwon recorded a plus net migration rate of 4.8%, 1.3% and 1.1%, respectively. On the other hand, Seoul, Daegu and Ulsan recorded a minus net migration rate of -1.2%, -0.8% and -0.8%, respectively.
