BY THE GOVERNOR:

**FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, IN CHEROKEE COUNTY,
AND AT ALL DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT
THE STATE OF GEORGIA ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF**

WHEREAS: Trooper Chase Winston Redner, 31, with the Georgia State Patrol was killed in the line of duty on Tuesday, February 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS: Trooper Redner honorably served with the Georgia Department of Public Safety after graduating from the 103rd Trooper School with the Georgia State Patrol in 2018; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Trooper Redner's service to the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building, in Cherokee County, and at all Department of Public Safety locations throughout the State of Georgia to half-staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE
MEMORY OF TROOPER CHASE WINSTON REDNER, PURSUANT TO THE
AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS
HEREBY**

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building, in Cherokee County, and at all Department of Public Safety locations throughout the State of Georgia on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, the day of Trooper Redner's interment, until sunset.
